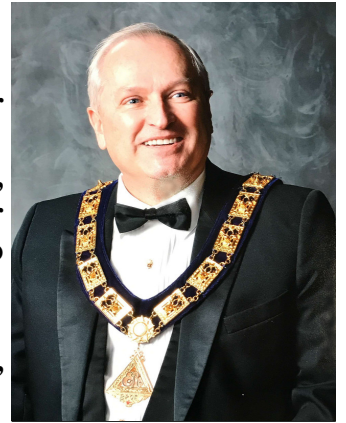
August 24th-26th Elks camping at the Lake Dubay county campground and park, come on down for the weekend or just pack your cooler and make it a day trip.

NEWS FROM THE **LODGE SECRETARY**

At the recent Grand Lodge convention in San Antonio, the voting members of the Lodge took up three resolutions that could impact how our Lodges function. Grand Lodge released the proposed resolutions in advance so local Lodges could discuss them and give some direction to those who would represent them at the convention. The first resolution once again introduced the requirement of holding an initiation as part of the District Deputy inspection of the Lodge. The original resolution proposed by Utah required the officers to do the initiation, but Georgia offered an amendment that would allow anyone to do the parts. We supported the amended version. Next, Grand Island, Nebraska proposed allowing local Lodges to offer a special dues structure for married couples when both are members. We supported this resolution. The third resolution, proposed by Klamath Falls, Oregon would add allow the Board of Directors of an incorporated Lodge to control the club aspect of the Lodge rather than an officer or the trustees. Since we are incorporated, and this is how we operate our club, we support this resolution. I will report at a later date how the Grand Lodge as a whole voted on these resolutions.

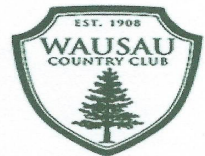
